Or the American Council for the Blind for her sister Annie. It was very Chelsea to think of someone else at times when she herself was in need.

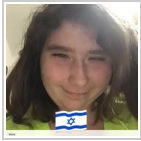

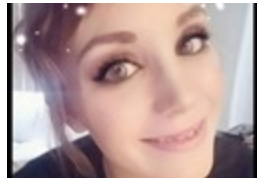
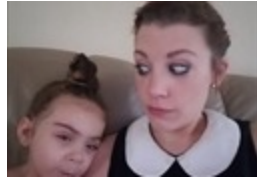
