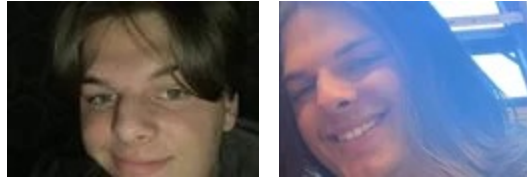
May he rest in peace. He was truly an angel, and I hope he's in heaven now, surrounded by light, love, and the peace he deserves.
