He continued as an OT until a disability cut his career short several years ago. Ryan was known to have a kind heart, especially for dogs and cats. He devoted much of his time and money to rescuing pets throughout the panhandle. As a friend or loved one, you could not find someone who was more loyal or generous than Ryan.
