Scott Brim, 56, of Amarillo passed away on August 21, 2024.

Scott was born on March 8, 1968 in Denton, Texas. He moved to Amarillo as a child, where he graduated from Amarillo High School in 1986. He then enlisted in the United States Army, where he proudly served until his honorable discharge in 1988. Following his discharge, Scott returned to Amarillo. Scott was a fighter at heart.
